## Request:

Q/ Are civilian direct recruit police support staff (civilians) in the Police Service of Northern Ireland included/protected by

The Redundancy Payments (Continuity of Employment in Local Government etc (Modification) Order (Northern Ireland) 1999.- **For continuity purposes** 

I.E. - If they worked for the PSNI and were employed directly, with no break in employment, next by a Local Authority in NI, would their PSNI service count as continuous service alongside the employment term of the local authority??

If at all possible a yes or no would suffice please.

## Answer:

In response to the specific circumstances outlined in your question the answer is yes.

By way of context S. 6(1) of the Police NI Act 2000 effectively means that reference to the Police Authority of NI in the Modification Order 1999, should be interpreted as a reference to the Northern Ireland Policing Board.

On that interpretation, if a former Police Support Staff Member of the Board subsequently moved employment to one of the Local Authorities or bodies **specifically prescribed in Schedule 1 of the Modification Order 1999**, **and had no break in employment**, then it is correct to say that they would benefit from continuity of employment for the purposes of The Redundancy Payments (Continuity of Employment in Local Government etc. (Modification) Order (Northern Ireland) 1999.
