## OCTOBER ACCOUNTABILITY SESSION

At the October 2024 Accountability Session, Information Commissioner John Edwards presented the findings of his investigation into the PSNI Data Breach. Questions to the Chief Constable focused on removal of 'hate' material, the draft Programme for Government, PSNI's Digital Strategy, payment of the Revised Environmental Allowance, revenue raising within policing, disclosure procedures, tackling paramilitarism and drug dealing.
