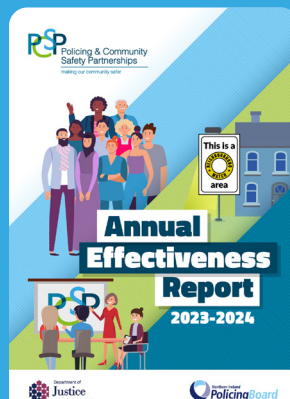
ROADS POLICING

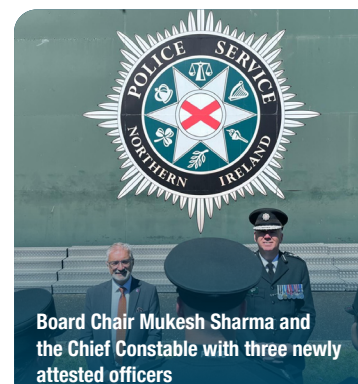
