Request:

I write to request information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 concerning the Specialist Medical Practitioner (SMP) Forum held on 28 September 2021.

As this request concerns a single identified meeting and a limited number of clearly identifiable records, I trust it can be processed within the appropriate cost limit under section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.
