# Request:

This is a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act regarding NI-CO (Northern Ireland Co-operation Overseas) monthly reports.

Please confirm possession of and provide the following information held by Northern Ireland Policing Board.

NI-CO (Northern Ireland Co-operation Overseas) Monthly Reports between January 2014 and July 2019.

# Answer:

The Policing Board has identified a total of 23 documents that fall within the scope of your request.

Copies of these documents have been enclosed for your information. We have withheld the names of individuals named in these documents. This personal information is exempt from disclosure to you under section 40(2) by virtue of section 40(3)(a)(i) of the FOIA. Section 40(2) allows a public authority to withhold information from a response to a request for information under the FOIA when the information requested is personal information relating to someone other than the requester and its disclosure would contravene one of the data protection principles. The first data protection principle requires personal data to be processed fairly and lawfully. This personal data is exempt from disclosure under section 40(2) of the FOIA as, in our view, it would be unfair to provide it to you, and therefore disclosure would be in contravention of the first principle of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). This is an absolute exemption and there is no requirement to conduct a public interest test.


