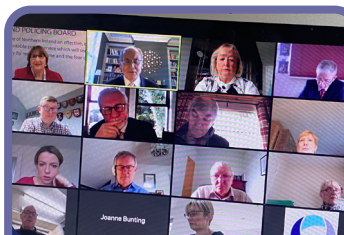
Police Property Fund Grants Scheme opens
