**Request:** Under the new 2016 Regulations for PSNI Disciplinary matters how many Ex-Police Officers have appeared at Police Appeal Tribunals, as administered by the Policing Board, in an unrepresented / self-represented manner?

**Answer:** Since the enactment of the Police Appeals Tribunals Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2016 on 1 June 2016, where it has been determined that an appeal must be dealt with at a hearing under Regulation 13(3), the Policing Board has administered two appeals by ex-police officers who self-represented at respective hearings before the Police Appeals Tribunal.
