## Answer:

With regards to the panel member notes from your interview, this iinformation is deemed to be personal information. Therefore as per the exemption at Section 40 (1) (Applicant's Own Personal Data) of the FOI Act we have not supplied you with this information as part of your FOI request. This is an absolute exemption and therefore the Board is not required to complete a Public Interest Test. However, we will process this part of your request as a Subject Access Request under the Data Protection Act 1998. You will receive this information separately.
