Chief Executive/Co-Director of Northern Ireland Alternatives, a community based restorative justice organisation that works closely with all statutory agencies within the Criminal Justice system, including Probation and the PSNI. Northern Ireland Alternatives is the umbrella organisation for 5 satellite offices – North Belfast Alternatives, Shankill Alternatives, East Belfast Alternatives; South Belfast Alternatives and Bangor Alternatives.

- For the financial year 2017/2018, Northern Ireland Alternatives receive grant funding from the PSNI for the delivery of the MACS service (Mediation and Community Support), a partnership between NIA, NIHE and PSNI. This funding supported service delivery work in the Shankill, North Belfast and Bangor offices.
- Individual satellite offices also receive grants from the PCSPs for the financial year 2017/2018 to help deliver against PCSP Action Plans.

Northern Ireland Alternatives also receives Fresh Start funding through PBNI to help meet the Fresh Start core objective Rec B12.
