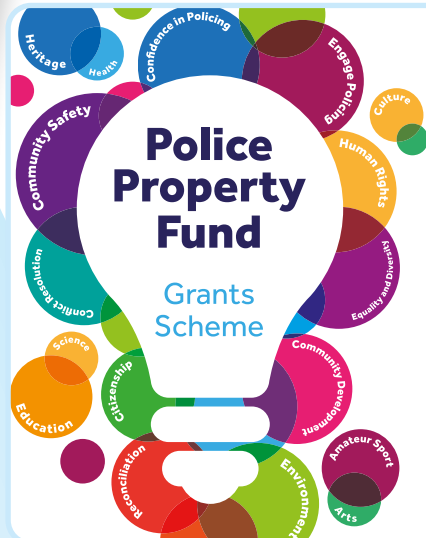
NEW OFFICER ATTESTATION
